- The Two Greatest Commandments

  - Deuteronomy 6:6-9
- The Golden Rule Redefined
  - We are to treat others well \_\_\_\_\_ the expectation that we will be treated well in return.
    - Luke 6:27-36
  - Four Greek Words for Love
    - **Φιλέω** (Phileō) – \_\_\_\_\_ Love
    - **Στοργή** (Storgē) – \_\_\_\_\_ Love
    - **Ερως** (Eros) – \_\_\_\_\_ Love
    - **Ἀγάπη** (Agapē) – \_\_\_\_\_ Love
