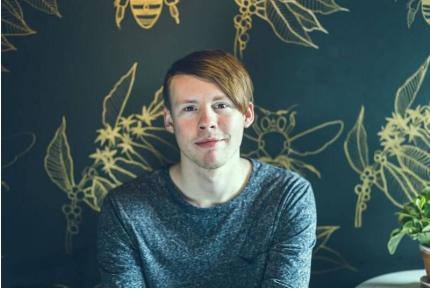


CANYONS - COREY VOSS
