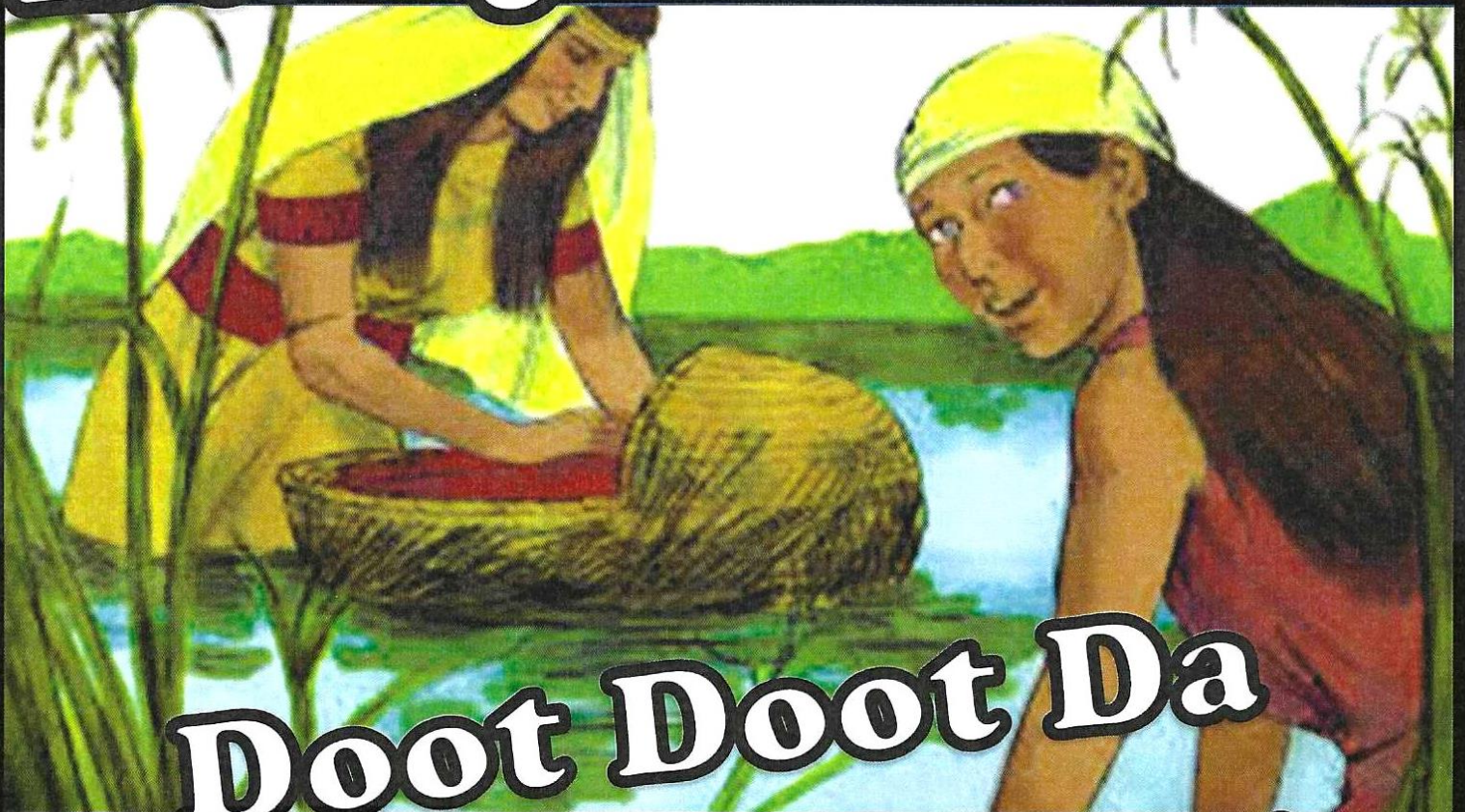

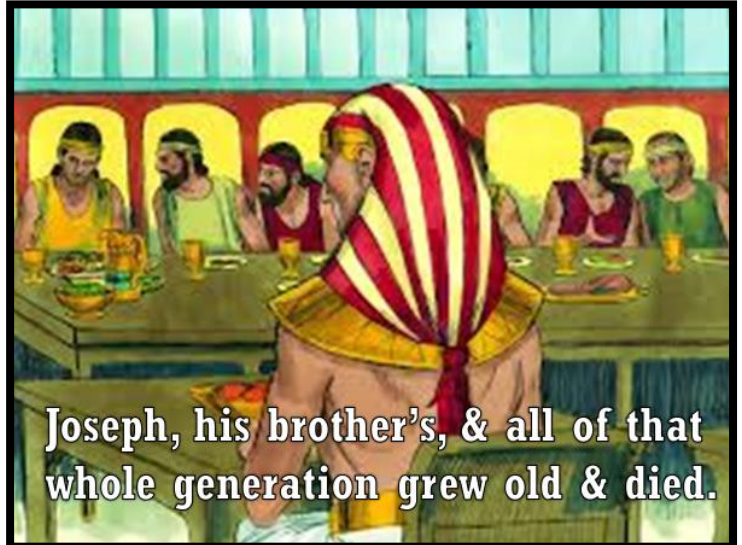

About 350 years passed since Joseph brought his family to Egypt. They had very large families, lots of livestock, & were very rich because the king had been very good to them.

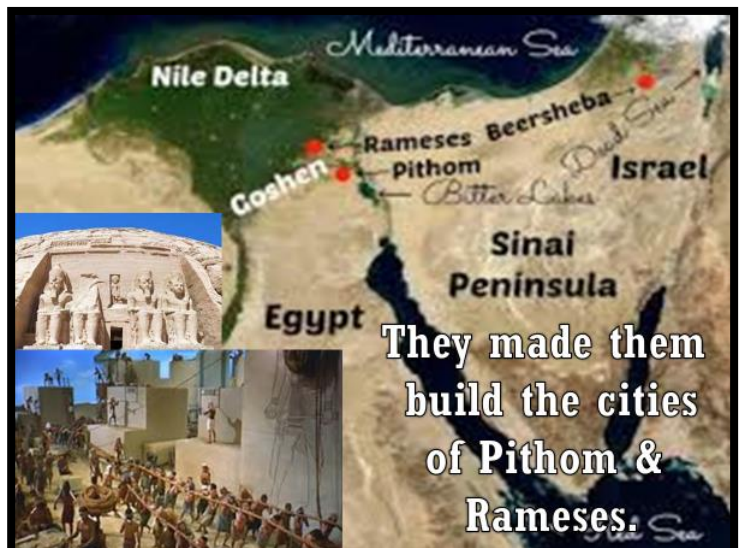
Then a new king that didn't know anything about Joseph came to power in Egypt.



"Look, there are to many of these Israelites. If one of our enemies gets them to fight for them we are in trouble!"

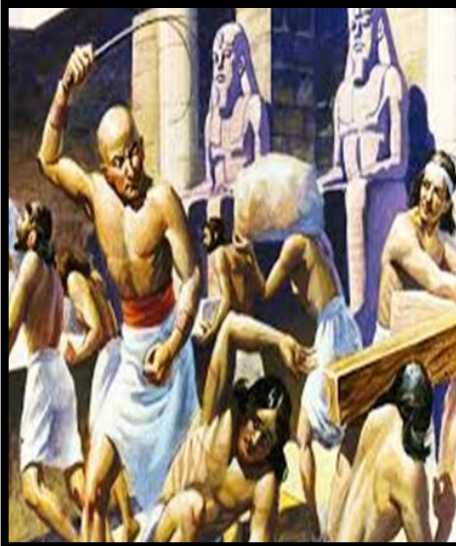


**So they made the Israelites slaves!**

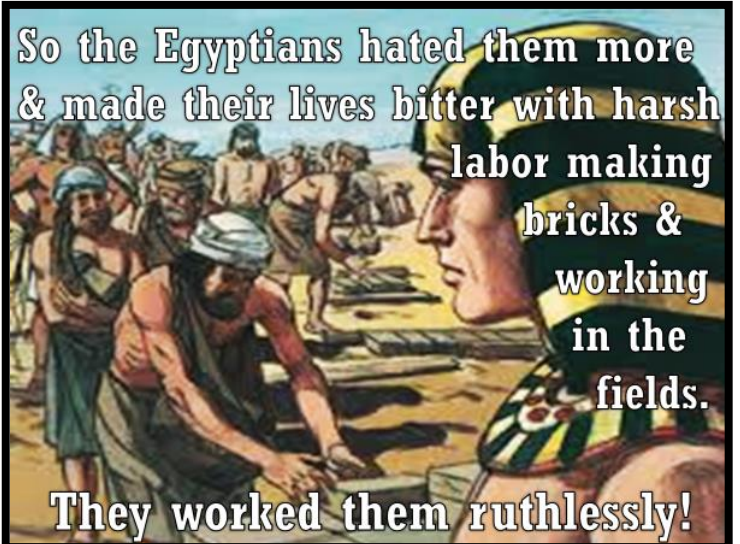


They made them build the cities of Pithom & Rameses.



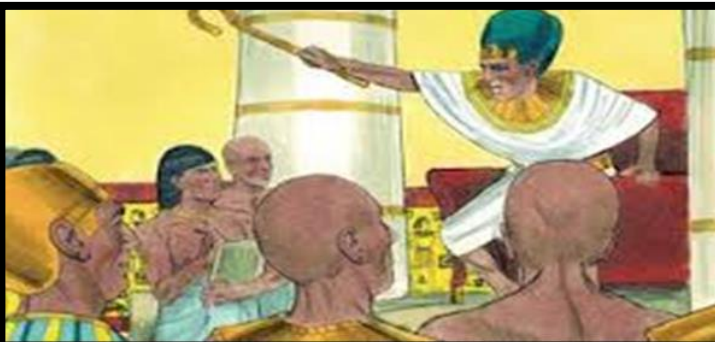


**But the meaner they were the more the Israelites multiplied & kept spreading.**

**They worked them ruthlessly!**

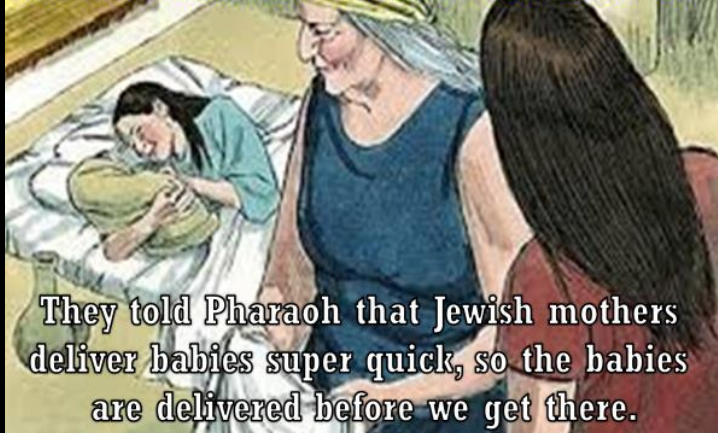


**Pharaoh gave orders to the midwives

**They told Pharaoh that Jewish mothers deliver babies super quick, so the babies are delivered before we get there.**

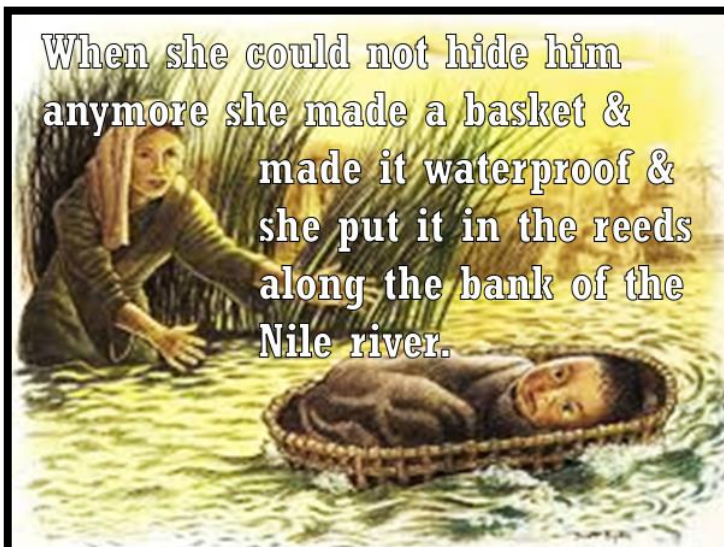
**Throw every Hebrew boy in the river, but the girls may live!**



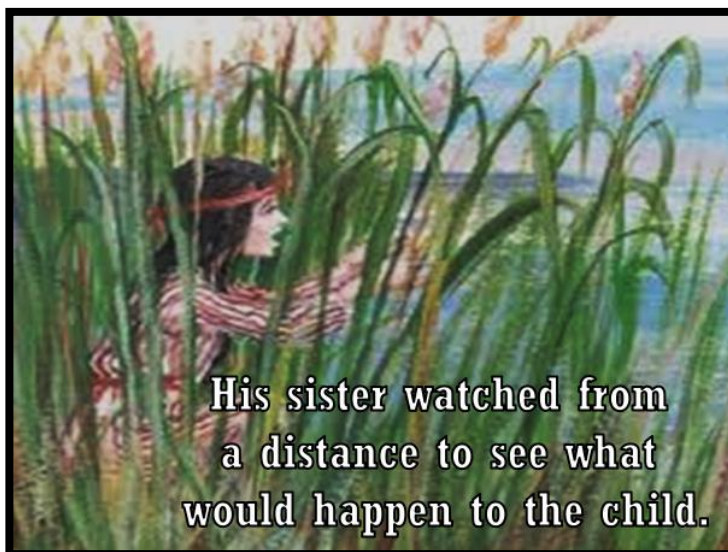




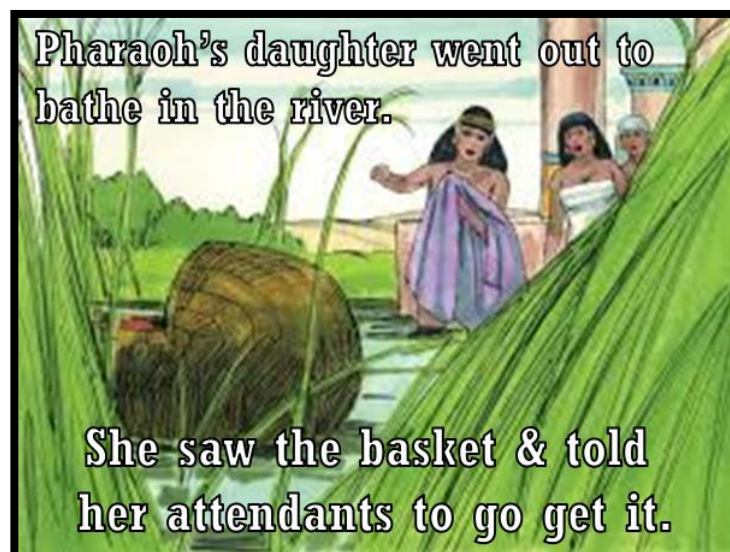
A Levite man & woman got married & had a son, they hid him for 3 months from the Egyptians.



When she could not hide him anymore she made a basket & made it waterproof & she put it in the reeds along the bank of the Nile river.

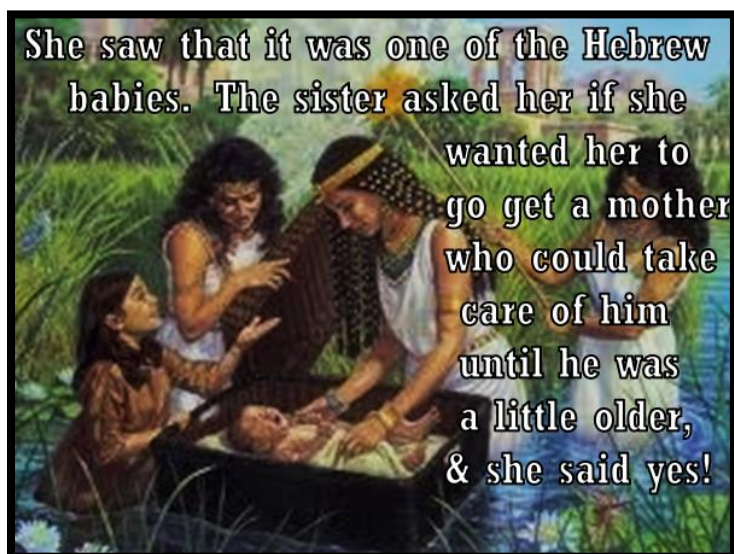


His sister watched from a distance to see what would happen to the child.

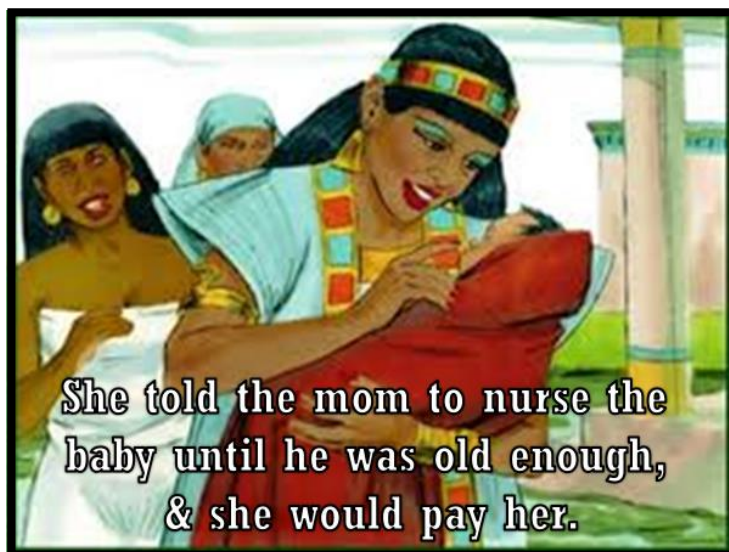


Pharaoh's daughter went out to bathe in the river.

She saw the basket & told her attendants to go get it.

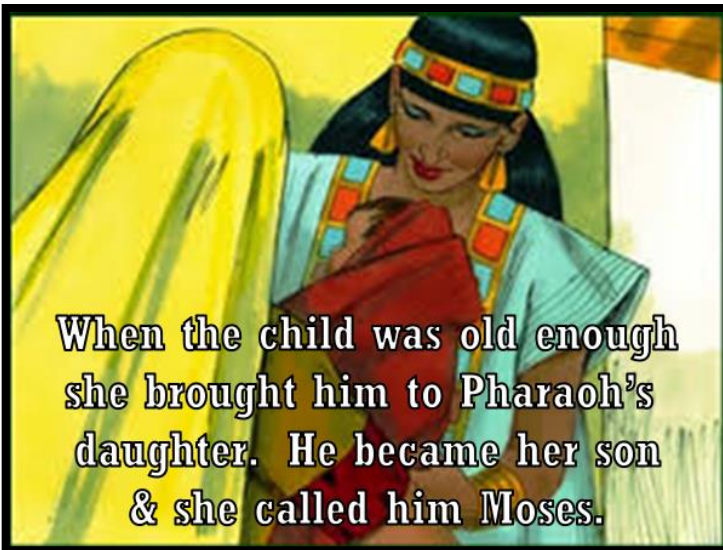


She saw that it was one of the Hebrew babies. The sister asked her if she wanted her to go get a mother who could take care of him until he was a little older, & she said yes!

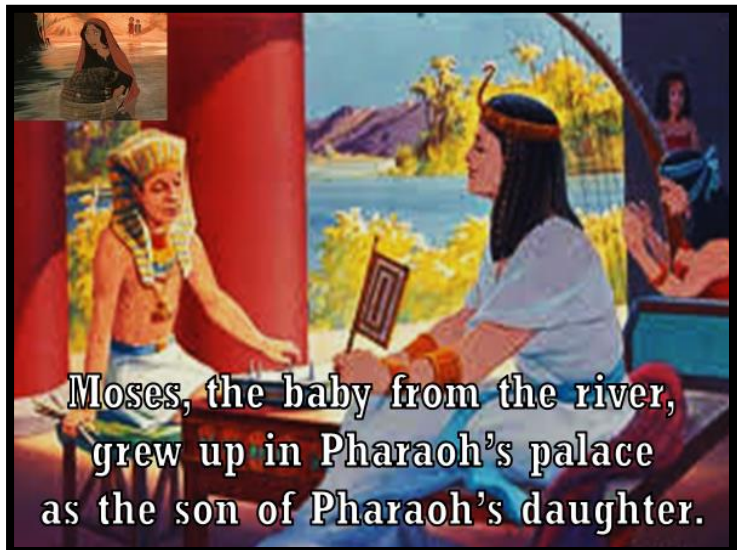


She told the mom to nurse the baby until he was old enough, & she would pay her.

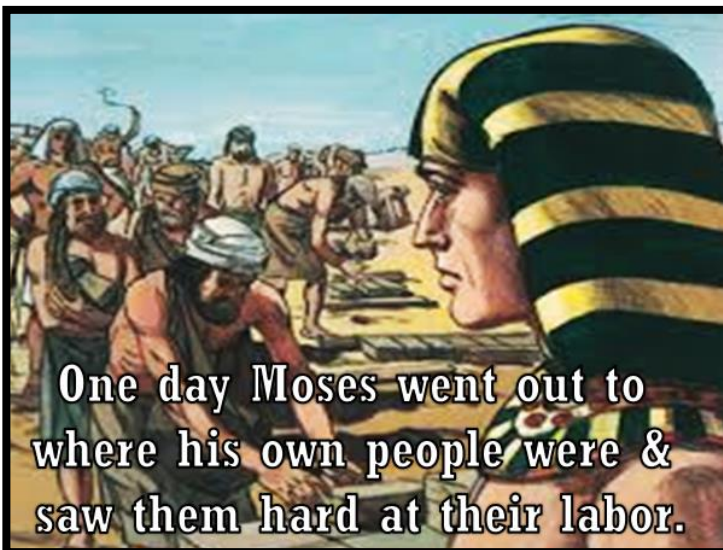




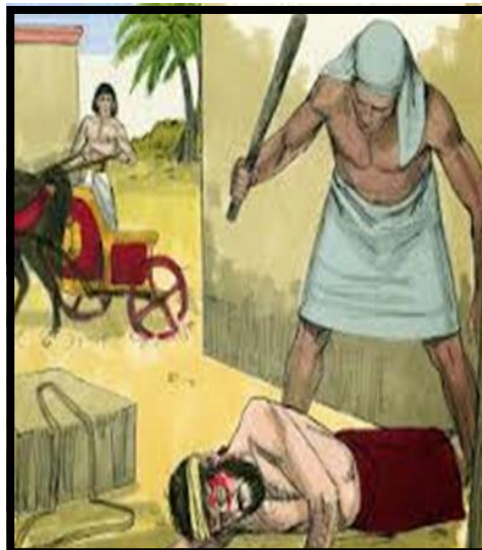
When the child was old enough she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter. He became her son & she called him Moses.



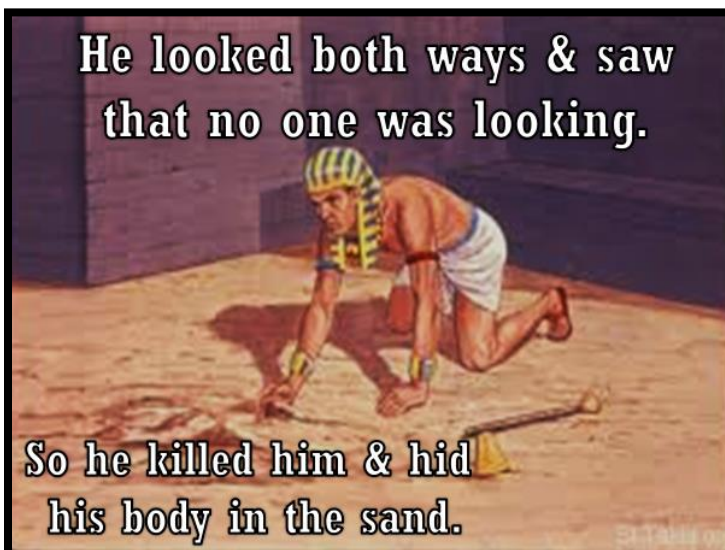
Moses, the baby from the river, grew up in Pharaoh's palace as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.



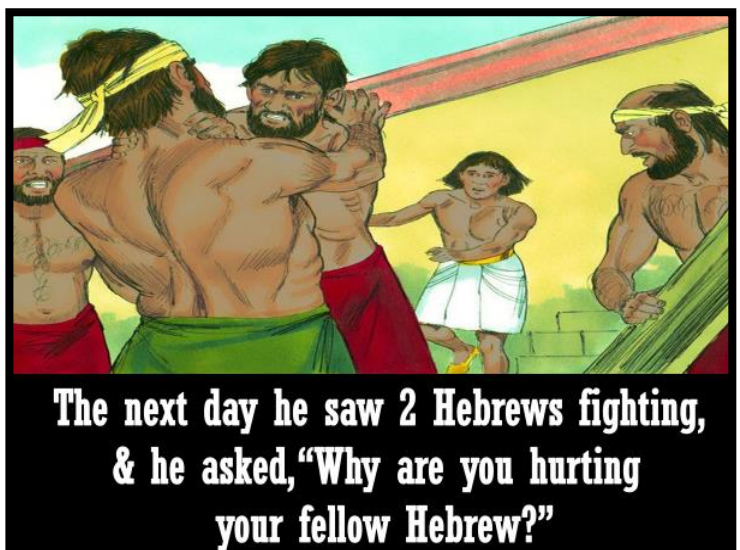
One day Moses went out to where his own people were & saw them hard at their labor.



He saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his own people.

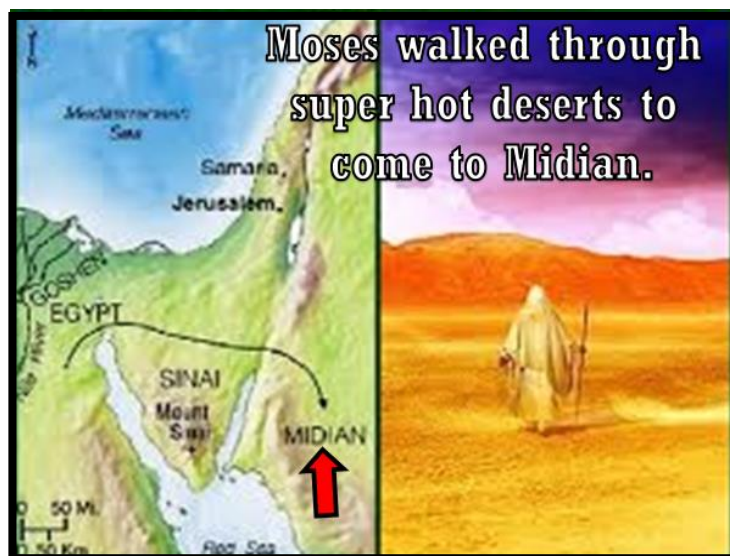
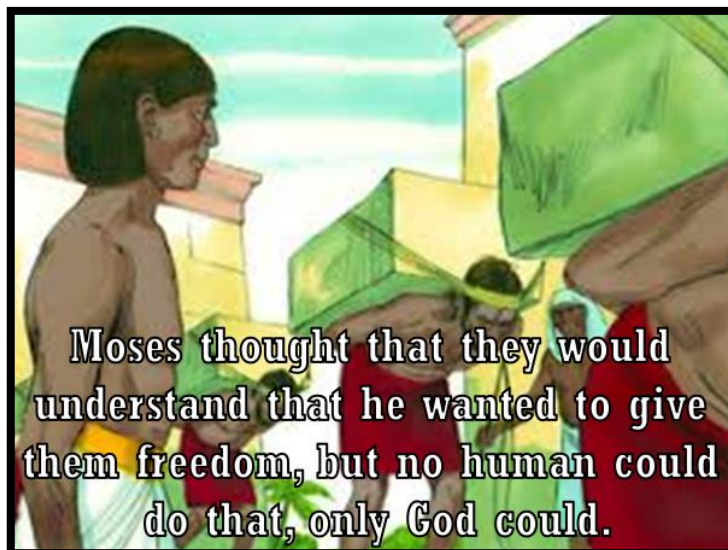
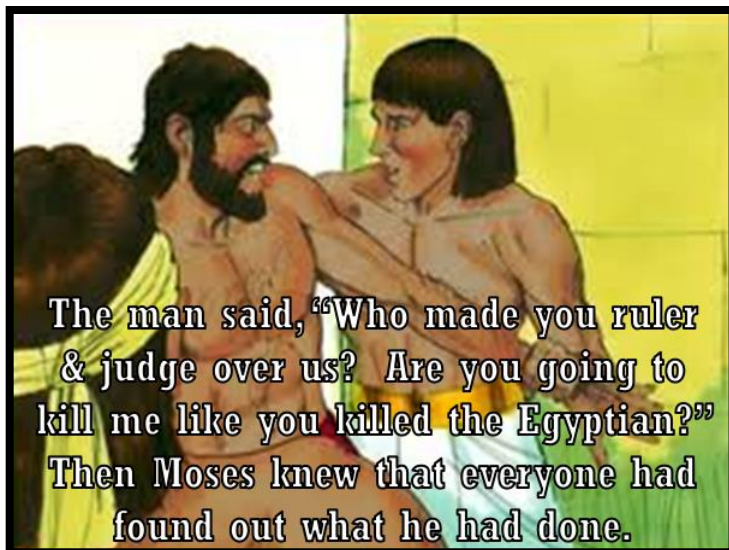


He looked both ways & saw that no one was looking. So he killed him & hid his body in the sand.


