To put God in His rightful place means to:


Obey, Honor, & Worship God & God alone!

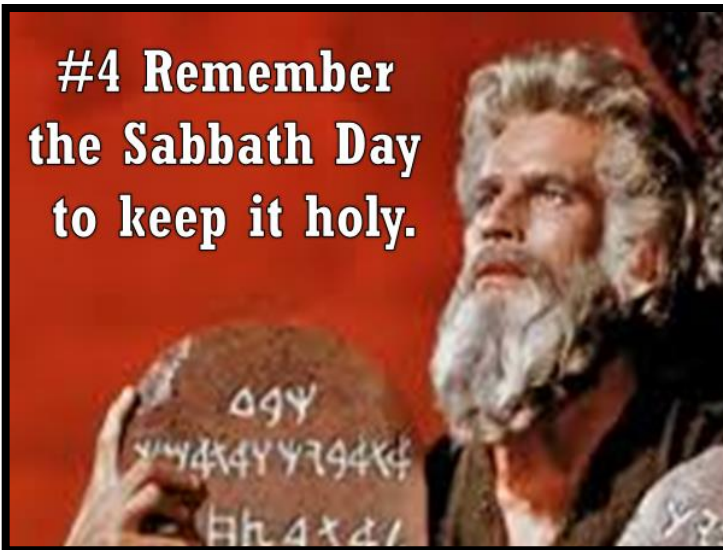

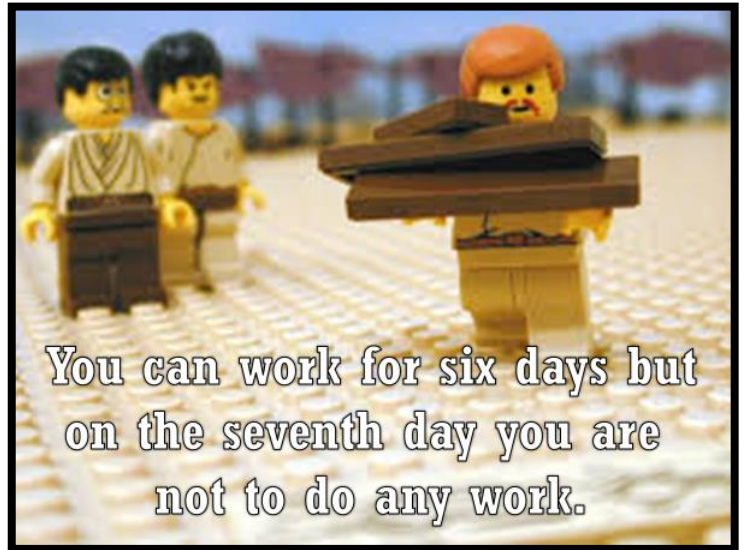
You are showing disrespect for God & misusing His name!

(Respect)

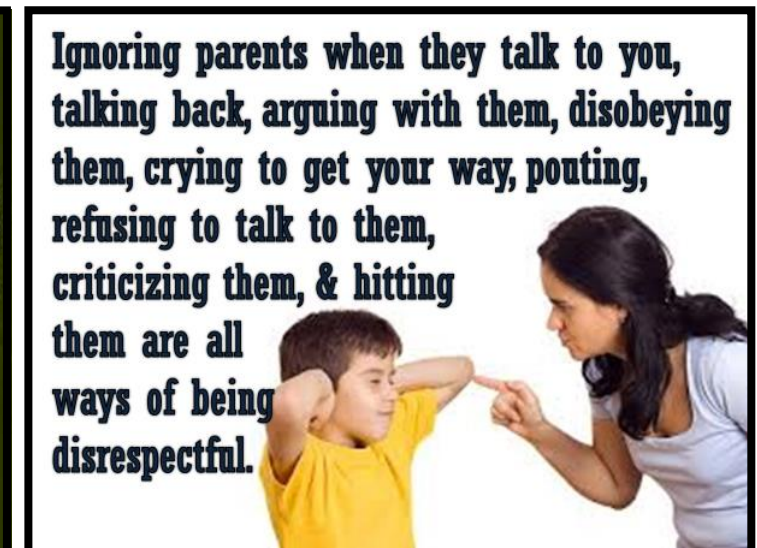


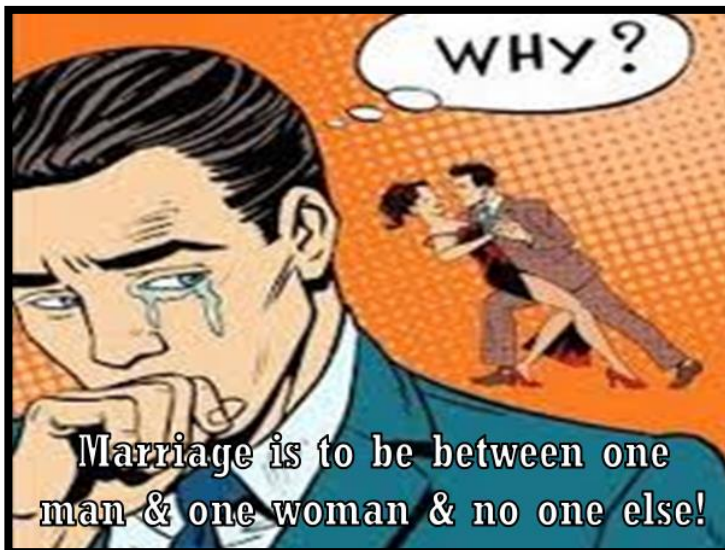

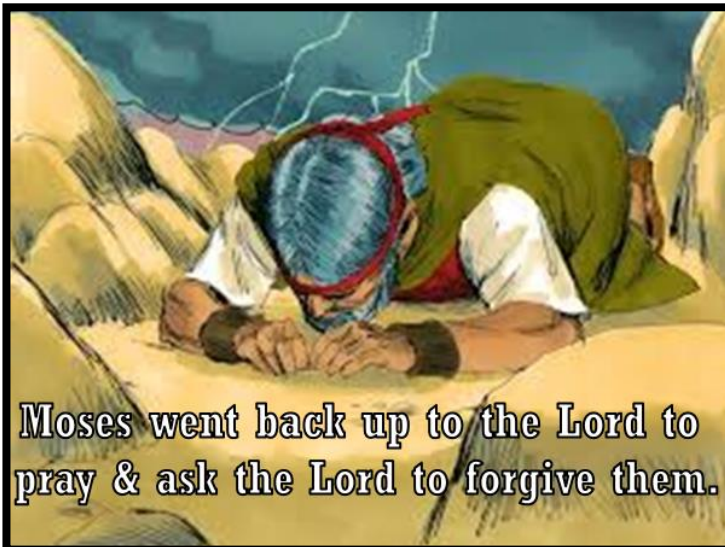
**Ignoring parents when they talk to you,
