- Issue: What must I do to be saved?
- Final recommendation: Faith + Nothing
 - o But some recommendations for fellowship...
- Question: What is our relationship to the Law?
- Answer:
 - Jesus "fulfilled" the Law Matthew 5:17 (& 18!)
 - Since we are united in Christ, we have also died to the Law -Galatians
 2:19-20
 - The purpose of the Law Galatians 3:23-25
 - We are no longer obligated to the Law Galatians 5:1,3-6 (4)
- Implications for our life today:
 - o Does that mean I can do whatever I please?
 - No! We are called to Holiness Galatians 5:16-26; Ephesians
 4:1 Ephesians 5:1-2; Colossians 3:5-17; 1 Peter 1:14-16
 - So, what value does the OT have for us today?
 - 2 Timothy 3:16 "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful..."
 - **1 Cor 10:11** (see also 1 Cor 10:12-13)
 - O What about the 10 Commandments?

- 7. No adultery Matthew 5:27-28Matthew 19:9; 1 Cor 6:9-10; James 2:11
- 8. No stealing Ephesians 4:28
- 9. No lying Colossians 3:9; Revelation 21:8
- 10. No coveting Romans 7:7; Colossians 3:5
