Review: Final call to stand firm! 4:1

- 4:1 – That’s how you do it!

Peace in Our Relationships 4:2-3

- Euodia & Syntyche: Personality conflict? – Both had been battle-tested!
- A little help here? – Loyal yokefellow

Peace in Our Hearts 4:4-7

- Call to Rejoice! 4
 - Always – “always, at all times, on every occasion’
- Call to gentleness 5
 - Gentleness – used of an attitude of kindness where the normal or expected response was retaliation.
- Call to prayer 6-7
 - Don’t: Be anxious – concern based on apprehension about possible danger or misfortune
 - Do: Pray! – Worship, making needs known, appreciation
 - Result: The peace of God!
 - Guard – A garrison; to prevent a hostile invasion.

Peace in Our Minds 4:8-9

- Whatever is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent or praiseworthy
 - **think about these things**
- Whatever you have learned, received, heard from me, or seen in me
 - **put [these things] into practice**

Keys:

- Have you lost your peace? Are you filled with anxiety?
 - Relationships? Heart? Mind?

Application:

- Which area do you need to address in your life?
 - Relationships? Heart? Mind?
