The Original Problem – Sin

- On the day you eat of it, you will surely die. Genesis 2:16-17
- The woman and the man ate it. Genesis 3:6-7

Our Solution to the Problem of Sin –

•	Cover-up – "They sewed fig leaves together"	3:7
•	Denial – "They hid from the LORD God"	3:8
•	Justifying – "I heard you in the garden and I was afraid"	3:10
•	Blame game – "The woman you put here."	3:12

Problem: None of these options work!

Immediate Consequences for Sin / Lingering Consequences

- Separation from presence of God Genesis 3:23-24; Isaiah 59:2
- Suffering & Sorrow Genesis 3:16-19; Romans 6:16; Hebrews 2:14-15
- Death Genesis 3:19; Romans 5:12; Colossians 2:13; Ephesians 2:1

The 1st Covenant – Law Deuteronomy 4:6, 9-10

- Sacrifice of Blood Leviticus 17:11; Hebrews 9:22
- Genesis 3:21 Garments of skin.

The Problem with the 1st Covenant

- Continually repeated Hebrews 10:11
- Inadequate Hebrews 9:9-10,13
- Obsolete Hebrews 8:7, 13

Question: Why wait so many years before sending Jesus?

- Because we are stubborn and slow to learn Isaiah 48:4
 - We needed to learn that the problem is greater than we can manage!
 - o If we needed more information, God would have sent an educator.
 - o If we needed more resources, God would have sent a financier.
 - o If we needed more courtesy, God would have sent Miss Manners.
 - If we only needed better clothing, God would have sent a fashion designer.

The solution – Jesus Christ!
