"Fret NOT!"	1-6
• Don't Worry! (See 1 Peter 5:7; Phil. 4:6-7)	1-2
 Fret – (Hebrew) to be kindled (get fired up over); to be aroused & 	
burn with anger	
 Fret = To be consumed with worry, vexation, or annoyance. From the Middle English "freten" (to eat up or consume). 	
 Do not be envious – jealous of another; ill-will ranging to anger 	
 Evil men/ Those who do wrong 	-
• Their end: Fade away!	
Do the Right Thing!	3-4
 Trust in the Lord = Call to active obedience! 	
 Do good. (See Gal. 6:9-10) 	
 Dwell in the Land – the place of God's provision for you 	
 Delight yourself in the LORD! 	
 Delight – to take pleasure/ thoroughly enjoy. 	
 Result: He will give you the desires of your heart. 	
• All-In!	5-6
 Commit your way 	
 He will make you shine! 	
God's Got This!	7-11
Chill Out 7-8	
 Be still & wait patiently – Don't get "hot and bothered." 	
 Playing the Long Game 	9-11
 God's final answer – The wicked cut off / the righteous inh 	
 Look all you want – you won't be able to find the "wicked" 	
\circ The meek will inherit the land (See Matthew 5:5!)
