Matthew 22:34-36

Jesus being tested: "What is the greatest command?"

- #1 - Love God – First and greatest
  - Heart, Soul, Mind – Every fiber of your being! (Deuteronomy 6:5)
  - See Matthew 28:16-20!
    - Go and make disciples!
    - Of all nations! (see Acts 1:8)

But wait, there's more...

Matthew 22:39-40

- #2 - Love your neighbor (see Leviticus 19:18)
  - As yourself
  - All the Law and Prophets hang on these two –

Question: What does it look like to love others?

- Who is my neighbor? - Luke 10:25-37
  - Do we even see our neighbors?
- How much do I have to love? –
  - "It's the thought that counts." – See James 2:15-16; 1 John 3:17-18
  - "Do I have to love them?" – 1 John 4:19-21
  - "What about my rights?" – 1 Corinthians 8:9; Romans 14:19; Philippians 2:4

Question: Are we willing to pay the price?

- How much did God give? – John 3:16
  - He gave the greatest gift – His own Son.
- How much are we willing to give? – John 15:13
  - Are we sure we would lay down our life for others?

Application:

- What price was paid for me?
- What price are we willing to pay to see others know Jesus?
