o Problem: Praying for the benefit of an audience

Result: No one is listeningAlternative: Praying in privateResult: God will reward you!

Wrong Method: Verbal Vomit
 Matthew 6:7

Problem: Wearing God out with our words

Result: Prayer doesn't work due to the volume of words.

Alternative: Just don't.

Result: Your Father knows before you speak...

Wrong Attitude: Retribution
 Matthew 6:14-15

Problem: No mercy.Result: No mercy.

Alternative: Forgiveness.

Result: Forgiveness.

• Wrong Purpose: All about me. Luke 11:9-13

Purpose: Not about me!Goal: According to His Will!

• Wrong Desires: Genie-in-a-bottle John 14:13-14

o Problem: Selfish desires (Compare with James 4:3)

o Solution: What does God desire? See 2 Peter 3:9/ John 12:32

• Wrong Spiritual Condition: Bloody hands Isaiah 1:15-18

Problem: Covered in sin.Result: No answered prayers.Alternative: Start acting right!
