Verse: Psalm 107:1-3

Psalm 107

- Call to Praise 1-3
- Picture #1 – Lost in a wide world: Love brings us home! 4-9
 - Threatening situation: Lost in the wilderness
 - Prayer: They cried out to the LORD in their trouble...
 - Divine Response: He delivered them!
 - Call to thankfulness: Unfailing love and wonderful deeds – He satisfies.
- Picture #2 – Hemmed in a narrow world: Love makes us free! 10-16
 - Threatening situation: Prisoners in chains (rebelled against God)
 - Prayer: They cried to the LORD in their trouble...
 - Divine Response: He brought them out and broke their chains!
 - Call to thankfulness: Unfailing love and wonderful deeds – He frees the prisoner.
- Picture #3 – Damaged in a sinful world: Love makes us whole! 17-22
 - Threatening situation: Sinful rebellion against God
 - Prayer: They cried to the LORD in their trouble...
 - Divine Response: He sent forth His word and healed them!
 - Call to thankfulness: Unfailing love and wonderful deeds – He rescues from the grave.
- Picture #4 – Beaten in a hostile world: Love brings us peace! 23-32
 - Threatening situation: Storms of life threaten to undo us
 - Prayer: They cried out to the LORD in their trouble...
 - Divine Response: He calmed the storm and brought them home!
 - Call to thankfulness: Unfailing love and wonderful deeds – He is worthy of our praise!
- The Providential Love of God 33-42
 - Warning: God can turn your lush garden into the Sahara!
 - Assurance: God can also turn the Sahara into the Garden of Eden!
 - Cycles of life: Abundance & Famine
- Final Admonition: Think about it! 43
 - Ponder the great love of the LORD!
